

Our 4K program provides young children in our community with a high-quality, early childhood program designed to get them ready for school—and a lifetime of learning.


## Curriculum & Instructional Goals

Our 4K curriculum is aligned to the Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards. A focus on learning through play and active exploration of the learning environment nurtures skills in literacy, numeracy and social-emotional development. Students also gain regular exposure to visual art, music, and physical education through classes taught by specialized, licensed educators.



#### SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING

Our approach supports the instruction of positive social and emotional skills in order to develop school readiness and growth in all students.



- Demonstrate self-regulation in the expression of feelings. needs, opinions and desires in a way that is appropriate to the situation.
- Appropriately name types of emotions and associate them with different facial expressions, words, and behaviors.

# **Program Details**

## TUITION-FREE PROGRAM 2hrc 45 min

4K is a tuition-free program for Meguon and Thiensville residents.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

A child must be four-years-old by September 1. 2023 to enroll in 4K for the 2023-24 school year.

#### **SCHEDULE**

- 4K is a half-day program. Classes are scheduled Monday through Friday from 9-11:45 a.m. (morning session) & 1:15-4 p.m. (afternoon session).
- Students participate in visual art, music and physical education classes taught by DPI-certified specialists. Students participate in art and music weekly, and physical education two times per week.

#### MORNING OR AFTERNOON PREFERENCE

If more families indicate a preference for a morning or afternoon section than we have available seats, we will enact a formal lottery system, which is the most equitable approach to situations in which capacity is limited. Availability of specific sections is dependent upon capacity and sufficient enrollment. We reserve the right to make final decisions on placement.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

Transportation is available on existing bus routes for both morning and afternoon sections. We provide shuttle service between the school and approved childcare providers within your child's attendance zone.

#### TRANSPORTATION (CONT'D)

 Families will indicate their transportation preferences during online enrollment.

### **Enrollment Process**

#### 1. COMPLETE ONLINE PRE-REGISTRATION

The first step to enroll your child in MTSD's 4K program is to complete online pre-registration. The online pre-registration window for 4K is open between February 14, 2023 and May 1, 2023. Through pre-registration, families will indicate their preferred morning or afternoon program option.

For those families for whom we have an email address on file, we will send an email with a link to pre-register when it opens. For all other families, a link will be available online at www.mtsd.k12.wi.us/4K beginning on February 14, 2023.

# 2. DOCUMENTATION AND PROOF OF RESIDENCY


After you complete online pre-registration, please submit the following documentation to Michelle Halloran at mhalloran@mtsd.k12.wi.us. Pre-registration is not complete until this documentation is received. Please provide during the pre-registration window (February 14, 2023-May 1, 2023). This can be done at any time school offices are open.

- Your child's official birth certificate (copies not accepted) or passport.
- Immunization record. Wisconsin Immunization Record form is enclosed.
- Proof of residency. If you are a resident of Mequon or Thiensville and your child lives with you, the following documents can be used to establish your child's residency.
  - 1. If you rent, a copy of your signed rental agreement.
  - 2. If you own a home, a copy of your real estate tax bill; if you recently purchased a home in Mequon or Thiensville, a copy of the closing statement.

After the pre-registration window closes, families can still enroll at their child's school. Please note that your child's placement will be subject to available space. You must bring your child's original birth certificate and proof of residency as described above.

# How to Register

- 1. You must register by mail or in person prior to enrolling in Kids' Campus. There is a \$25/per child annual registration fee (maximum \$50 per family for those with multiple children). Please mail the registration form with your check to the Mequon-Thiensville Recreation Department, or register in person with cash, check, or credit card at the Rec Department office in Range Line Center between the hours of 7:30 a.m.-4 p.m. You may not complete online enrollment until registration forms are completed and the registration fee has been submitted.
- 2. Enrolling in Kids' Campus. Parents will be given access to complete an online monthly care schedule and submit payments safely on the M-T Rec Department website once registration forms and fees are completed and submitted as in above

Please note: All enrollments need to be in on the Monday prior to the week care is needed. This allows for appropriate staff scheduling and accurate student rosters. (Example: If care is required the week of September 4-7, enrollments must be submitted 7 days in advance, by Monday August 27.)
